By contacting your filter specialist at 800-551-8517 you can create a custom time schedule for internet access! For example, Internet Access can be set to go **ON** from 9-10am, 1-2pm, and from 6-10PM ONLY! During **OFF** times the computer can be used, but without access to the internet! You can also set internet access to be turned off at night, "lights out, internet off, sleep tight!"
